

# 2010-2011 Classroom Supply Lists\*

**\*Please note:** There may be some adjustments to these classroom supply lists when we return in September.

## **Full Day Kindergarten Supply List**

**Please write your child's name on these items:**

A full size backpack (one that can easily fit 9" by 12" folders, and that can be brought back and forth to school DAILY)

Good quality watercolor paints (Prang or Crayola, 8 colors, Not Glitter)

Optional: a lunch box

**The following items will be shared with the class:**

**(These items will be turned in to Ms. Flocker and/or Mrs. Winkler)**

1 set of Crayola **Twistable** Colored Pencils

2 pink or white pearl erasers

10 or more glue sticks (We will ask for these all throughout the year...)

Large box of snack (enough for 26 students)

1 container of antibacterial **cleaning** wipes

1 container of antibacterial **HAND** wipes

**If your child's first name starts with A - P please buy:**

Large box of Kleenex tissues

1 box of quart or gallon size ziplock Storage baggies

**If your child's first name starts with R -Z, please buy:**

1 box of 5 ounce paper cups

2 Fine Point black Sharpie markers (not Ultra Fine)

Just FYI: **At the end of the year (May)**

your child will need three 1.5" 3-ring binders.

**\*\*\*We will provide pencils, crayons, scissors, and notebooks.**

Please, **NO** pencil boxes!

## **A.M. & P.M. KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST**

A full size backpack that can easily fit 9" by 12" folders, and that can be brought back and forth to school DAILY. It should have the student's name on it.

Colored pencils - 10-12 colored pencils	1 Large box of facial tissues
1 Box of crayons - 18-24 box only	1 Container of disinfectant wipes
2 Pink pearl erasers	2 Large boxes of crackers for snack
Fiskar scissors - pointy	Backpack
2 Built-in pencil sharpeners w/shavings container	
Good quality pencils (American General or Ticonderoga)	

## **SECOND GRADE SUPPLY LIST**

1 Backpack (brought daily)	1 Pink Pearl eraser
12 or more Glue sticks	1 - 4 ounce size white "school" glue
1 Box of 24 Crayola crayons	Hand sanitizer
Medium (broad) and Fine tip Crayola markers (10-pack)	
2-4 Containers of disinfectant wipes (Clorox or Lysol)	
No binders, please

## THIRD GRADE SUPPLY LIST

- Backpack
  - 1 Box of colored pencils
  - 1 Box of crayons
  - Medium and Fine tip markers
  - 8 Glue sticks
  - 1 Highlighter
  - 1 Pencil box
  - 1 - 2" Three Ring Binder - this will be for your child alone, to use all year
  - 1 Composition notebook, 9-3/4 X 7-1/2, wide rule
  - 3 Spiral-bound notebooks (red, blue and yellow, wide ruled - no names, please)
  - 1 Box Ziploc baggies - Last Names A-J Sandwich sized, K-Q Quart sized, R-Z Gallon sized
- Third grade students will be using community supplies. No names are needed on items. Any "special" items should be kept at home. Thank you.

## FOURTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST

Please have items the first day of school, if possible. If your student has a lunchbox, please label it with their name.

- Backpack
- 2 Pencil pouches, look for a durable zipper.
- Handheld pencil sharpener with shavings catcher (these have heavy use, go for durability)
- 1 inch binder
- 4 Subject dividers WITH pockets
- 4 Spiral bound notebooks (wide rule)
- 3 Composition notebook, 9  $\frac{3}{4}$  X 7  $\frac{1}{2}$ , wide rule
- 3 Boxes of pencils, sharpened
- Highlighter (any color)
- Sharpie permanent marker, double sided, fine and extra fine point (label with name)
- 2 Red pens for editing/self grading, fine point
- 2 Pink Pearl type erasers
- Glue sticks
- Colored pencils
- Markers
- 1 Large box tissue
- 1 or 2 Containers anti-bacterial wipes
- Student Scissors (label with name)

## FIFTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST

Accordion folder for organizing schoolwork by subject *OR* 4 or 5 flat pocket folders for various subjects

4-5 Single subject spiral notebooks

Loose-leaf notebook paper

1 Pencil pouch or a *small* pencil box

Several pencils

Eraser(s)—your favorite kind

Ballpoint pen

1 or 2 Glue sticks

Small packet of colored pencils, crayons, or colored felt-tip markers

Scissors

Ruler with customary and metric units

1 or 2 Boxes of tissues, to donate to the class

*Optional*—one USB flash drive for use in the computer lab.

*Optional*—one calculator
