

# Native American Pathfinder

**Scope:** This pathfinder is a research guide to resources covering the topic of Native American tribes. It can provide guidance to a variety of sources for 5<sup>th</sup> grade students, teachers and parents looking for information about Native American tribes. This document will be available as a PDF file (with hyperlinks to internet based sources) on the Media Center webpage.

**Introduction:** The diversity of Native American tribes within the United States is vast as the regions they come from. It is fascinating to explore the culture, art, languages and communities of the many tribes in the United States. As the original Americans, many of the Native tribes were moved to reservations away from their homelands. Some tribes have confederated such as the Grand Ronde. The Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde represent the tribes of the Umpqua, Molalla, Rogue River, Kalapuya, and Chasta. It is important to study the culture and heritage of Native American tribes so that we have a better understanding of those who lived in this land before it was “discovered” by the Europeans. We can also help keep native traditions alive by studying them and therefore promoting an interest in them.
